

Dr. Peter Verlič graduated in Civil Engineering at the University of Ljubljana, Faculty of Civil Engineering (road and railway infrastructure design, traffic planning and modelling, traffic safety) in 1987 and obtained Master's degree in 1994. In 2002 he obtained also Ph.D degree in Civil Engineering.

He was director Slovenian Railways' Institute of Traffic and Transport Ljubljana (Prometni institut Ljubljana) in years 1993-1998.

In year 2000 and 2004-2008 he was State secretary at the ministry of Transport of Slovenia and Member of national parliament (2008-2011).

He has been involved in several projects related to transport in national and EU level. Recently he has been working on development concepts of rail infrastructure planning and maintenance in Slovenia (smart maintenance planning, rail infrastructure monitoring and diagnostics), integration of passenger transport, and on projects connecting the regions in and improving railways in South East Europe.

He is Assistant Professor at the New University Ljubljana, European Faculty of Law, Ljubljana (Slovenia) and Member of Council of Experts for Court expert opinions, Certified appraisal and Court interpretation, Government of the Republic of Slovenia.

Dr. Peter Verlič was the initiator of the establishment of the SEESARI initiative (South East Europe Strategic Alliance for Rail Innovation) and was elected as the first chairman in year 2016. He is director of Slovenian Railways' Institute of Traffic and Transport Ljubljana and Executive Chairman of SEESARI.
